## FAQ – frequently asked questions about the summer courses in Falkenberg

### **What is the target group for the courses?**

The courses are given at first academic level. They will be useful to all who are interested in or shall work with renewable energy sources. I think the courses shall be interesting for both technician and people who are interested in society, business, marketing and installation.

### **What is the exact date for the courses?**

Wind Power Technology: 8 - 18 June 2009

Bioenergy: 3 - 14 August 2009

Renewable Energy Sources: 17 - 28 August 2009

### **Can I send you my application form by e-mail or would you prefer ordinary mail?**

The application must be sent by ordinary mail. The application shall be signed and the copies attested. We will accept that the copies of the grades are in German. Send the application to:

### **What are the eligibility requirements and do I have to enclose anything to the application form?**

The conditions are not hard to fulfil, you shall be qualified to university studies in your country. In general it is the upper secondary school or corresponding. Knowledge in English is important. The copies you attach to prove your qualifications shall be attested by a person who also gives his telephone number or address.

### **How many places are reserved for students from outside Sweden?**

We will accept 20 - 25 students to each course. They can all be foreigners; it depends on how many that will apply. Our goal is that at least half of the students shall be foreign.

### **What is the accommodation like?**

The accommodation will be in small houses with "Bed and breakfast". The student has a shared room (often double room), and access to bathroom and kitchen. It will be up to 8 students in the same house. Lunch will be served close to the school that is called "Lärcentrum".

### **Do I have to organise and pay the trip to Sweden myself?**

Yes, you have to do that. The accommodation and the school are easy to reach from the railway station by city buses. It is good train connection from Copenhagen/Malmö and Gothenburg to Falkenberg.

### **How will the two weeks be organized? Will it be normal lectures with an exam or is it like a workshop where we do our own projects?**

The teaching consists of lectures, laboratory work and study tours. Parts of the course are studied as a project. Assessment consists of a written examination and approved report from laboratory work and project.
