## Introduction

High intensity university courses on RES and RUE will be held in Falkenberg, in collaboration with Halmstad University. The courses are aimed at competence building for future energy experts and people already working with energy issues. Around half of the ca. 20 participants per course are expected to come from other EU countries and normal European student mobility rules apply.

The various Energy in Mind! demonstration projects will be used extensively in the education. In total 8 summer courses will be held during the duration of the project .

#### Energy Courses in Falkenberg

During the next 4 years, Halmstad University will give two energy courses a year each lasting 2 weeks. The courses are given in English at a boarding school in Falkenberg. Falkenberg is leading in the area of solar thermal systems and wind energy in Sweden since the 80ies.

As the courses are held in the context of "Energy in Minds" and thus are supported by the Commission they will be free of costs both for education and boarding. About 20 – 25 students are accepted to every course. Topics in 2006 are:

**"Solar Heating Technology"** – 2 weeks in June 2006

**"Renewable Energy Sources"** – 2 weeks in August 2006

In summer 2006 two university courses are held in Falkenberg:

“Solar Heating Technology”, June 12-22

“Renewable Energy Sources”, August 7-18.
